Who we are:

Creating the future vision for one of Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada's most prized treasures, Assiniboine Park Conservancy (APC) is the not-for-profit organization that oversees Assiniboine Park's operations and ensures its ongoing redevelopment and financial viability. Our team is inspired to create and deliver extraordinary experiences for the people who visit and use the Park and Zoo including building friendly, supportive, effective relationships with stakeholders, community and the general public. We want to be a place where people share the wonders of nature in a way that inspires them to conserve it for the future.

The Opportunity:

We are seeking a full time Veterinary Intern, for a **one year term** position from July 1, 2021 to July 3, 2022. Reporting to the Director of Veterinary Services and Animal Welfare, the Veterinary Intern will be a key member of the Animal Health Management Team. The purpose of this internship is to provide graduate veterinarians exposure to diverse aspects of zoological practice and to utilize their skills in the healthcare of captive wildlife.

Your Role:

- Support preventative and clinical animal care for a diverse collection of over 1500 animals representing 400 different species;
- Perform medical, surgical and pathological case management tasks;
- Assist in training and supervising veterinary staff, technicians and students;
- Research and review current literature to prepare presentations to staff and veterinarians.

What you will need to have:

- A Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree (or equivalent)
- A minimum one (1) year of post-graduate clinical experience
- Experience involving work with zoo(s) or exotic animals is preferred
- Eligibility for licensing as a veterinarian in the Province of Manitoba

What you need to demonstrate to be successful in the role:

- A genuine interest in zoo and wildlife medicine;
- Effective communication skills in order to maintain respectful working relationships with fellow employees and with APC visitors;
- The ability to make effective animal healthcare decisions while working under stressful situations;
- Demonstrate a commitment to the principles of equity and diversity, and proven ability to work effectively with a diverse population.



- Proficiency with computer programs appropriate for related record keeping (Microsoft Office and ISIS animal record-keeping software such as ZIMS, etc.).
- Candidates must be physically capable of performing the duties of the position (documentation of physical capacity may be required).
- The successful candidate will be required to wear APC issued uniforms, provide their own safety footwear and inclement weather clothing.
- Successful candidates may be subject to a Criminal Record Check and Credit Check
