CONCENTRATION: WILDLIFE HEALTH MANAGEMENT

NUMBER OF POSITIONS AVAILABLE: 1

DESCRIPTION:

This residency is a 3-year (36 months), full time, graduate program of 108 credits obtained from clinical / paraclinical rotations. A specialized study diploma (D.É.S.) is awarded on completion of the program. The intensive clinical / paraclinical training is concentrated in the field of wildlife health management. This program meets the requirements of the American College of Zoological Medicine, targeting the Wildlife Health certifying examination. The resident will participate to the activities of the *Centre québécois sur la santé des animaux sauvages* of the *Faculté de médecine vétérinaire*. This center offers expertise in wildlife pathology and clinical services in wildlife health. Rotations in the *Service de médecine zoologique (Clinique des oiseaux de proie)*, the *Zoo de Granby*, the *Aquarium du Québec* and some governmental agencies are also part of the program. The resident is required to complete a research project in the field of wildlife health management. The realization in parallel of a M.Sc. program in wildlife epidemiology is highly recommended. An optional year of fellowship could be available at the end of the D.É.S program. Residents are eligible for 3 weeks of holidays per year which will be determined by the consultation committee and the supervisor. Any professional activities performed outside the residency program must be declared to the supervisor.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Doctor in veterinary medicine degree (DVM) or a diploma judged equivalent
- Have recently completed an internship or have equivalent experience
- Acquire a license to practice from l'Ordre des médecins vétérinaires du Québec before beginning the program
- Working knowledge of the French language
- Have a driver's license and live within 20 minutes of driving distance from the veterinary college

TUITION FEES (Amounts shown are in Canadian currency):

- Landed immigrants and Canadian citizens living in Quebec, French citizens, Francophone Belgian citizens : +/- \$5,000 / year
- Landed immigrants and Canadian citizens not living in Quebec : +/- \$12,000 / year

REMUNERATION:

- \$24,000 /1st year
- \$26,000 /2nd year*
- \$28,000 /3rd year*

To these amounts are added 3.6 % for benefits and 3 % for the payment of public holidays.

* Continuation of a second and third year depends on the mutual satisfaction of the resident and the Faculty.

The resident is allotted a total amount of \$3,000 to attend two conferences in his specialty during his/her program. (maximum amount per activity: \$2,000)

- Students having done a traineeship at the University Hospital must provide their assessment with their application.

Candidate selection

The selected candidate will be contacted on **March 3rd, 2021** by phone and email. Each candidate will have 24 hours to accept or decline the position. If a candidate withdraws, the next candidate on the rank list will be contacted until all positions are filled. The rank list will not be disclosed. This process can take several days. Candidates on the waiting list will be notified by email and a written letter. Candidates not selected will be notified in writing.
